Dallas street ministry checklist...

Sat. 3:00 pm - On the way to deliver a sewing machine to Niang's house. A man from Nepal came up to us and asked if we were Christians. He asked us to speak to a small group of Nepalese.

Got to speak to a leader of the Tiddim tribe about getting along with the other tribes. We told them how the Chin tribe bought food and drink for them to show them their love. They were amazed that the Chin would do this. It is beginning to look hopeful.

Sun. 2:00 pm – Asked the Mynamar Christian Church if they will go on the streets with me. Everyone raised their hand. We are going to have a blast!

Mon. 12 noon – Mang took our mission trip videos and showed them to everyone she could fit into her apartment. She told them the Gospel and then told them that there is now a team walking the streets who wants to help them get some furniture and will paint their apartment. She told them that this team comes in the name of the living God. They told her that these must be very “heavenly” people.

Mon. 7 pm – met with a local Burmese pastor who is also a refugee caseworker. We hit it off and decided to go on the streets together. Some Hindus invited us into their home and asked us, “How one could become a follower of Jesus?”

We talked for 30 min. and I gave the best Gospel presentation I have ever given in my life! Their reply was that my words are very good words and that they want to know of Jesus so that they can please ALL the gods!!!

Since we were getting nowhere I invited them to church to learn more and it appears this Sunday we will have a couple rows of Hindus coming out of curiosity!

Tues. 12 noon – Mang took an old packet of Sunday school material I had given her and invited all of her neighbors and taught them the entire packet of lessons! She wants to know if I have any more material so that she can continue teaching every day. Her classes are housewives and kids including Bhtuanese, Latinos, Muslims, Burmese, etc.

This lady is 8 months pregnant and walks the worst neighborhood in Dallas twice a week to come to our services –and refuses to let us give her a ride so that her neighbors won't be jealous!!! She sleeps on the floor and has nothing but a card table and a ratty old futon. We brought her a table and she started crying because she didn't

ask God for anything and now she is worried that her neighbors will be jealous that she has a table and they don't.

NOTE: I could go on but the bottom line is we need some help painting these apartments, witnessing to people, hauling furniture for those who have none – these people need to live like human beings and know who this living God is whom they have heard about.

They will SEE Him in action when they see YOU on the streets with us. As always, we can and ARE doing it alone –but it's a lot more fun with YOU there!

This is a work of God which is running on auto-pilot – as you might imagine the devil is ticked and crazy things come up every day –would you let us know you are praying for us?

By the way – we need Bibles – got any old Bibles you aren't using???
